PA Youth Turkey Hunt

Youth ages 16 and under have a chance to start turkey hunting season early on Saturday, April 22. This is only open to licensed junior hunters and properly permitted mentored hunters under the age of 16. They must be accompanied by an adult per the law.

An adult mentor may not accompany more than one hunter at any given time while hunting with a mentored hunter. The mentored program is meant for

One-on-One oversight.

The adult mentor and mentored youth may possess only one sporting arm between them. The adult must carry the gun or bow at all times while moving. Once in a stationary position, the mentored youth may hold it. The adult mentor must be within arms reach of the mentored youth hunter at all times while the youth is stationary and in possession of a sporting arm.

The statewide spring turkey season starts Saturday, April 29 through May 13. Hunting hours end at noon each day the season is open. Starting May 15-30, all day hunting is permitted.
