The American Marten were found in Pennsylvania forests up till the 1900's due to unregulated market hunting and trapping and deforestation. About 70% of their diets are made up of plants and insects. Occasionally they will eat birds, squirrels, rabbits, hares and other small animals but those are on a smaller basis within their diets. 
Indoor Pin Shoot
