Pittsburgh & Suburban Leage:

Irwin Sportsmen and ISA Post 228 will be competing as a combined team for the 2024-2025 season. The 2024-2025 schedule is 22 weeks total with two bye weeks from October 9th – April 2, 2025. The schedule has off weeks for holidays.. The league matches will all be shot at ISA on Orion A-17 targets. Targets will be mailed on Thursday mornings to the league and scored on the Orion scoring scanner.

The only league requirement for equipment is a .22 rifle with either iron sights or scope (per section 3.1 through 3.7 of the NRA rules). Additional equipment and clothing is optional. All three positions can be shot from standing. Equipment and Ammunition are per section 3 of the NRA Rulebook. The league follows the NRA rules: <u>nra-smallbore-rifle-rules.pdf</u>. Each week will be a 3-position shoot with 10 rounds per position, shooting on an A-17 target. The adults will shoot on Wednesday evening. We have 5 adults interested in shooting the league.

On July 12, the Pennsylvania Board of Game Commissioners approved mentor hunters with a mentor youth to accompany three (3) hunters: mentored youth, junior hunters or mentored adults. Previously the ruling was for a one-to-one mentor/mentee ratio. The change will go into effect for the fall hunting season.

Game Commission Needs Volunteers

The PA Game Commission, along with the Hawk Mountain Sanctuary has started the third Pennsylvania Bird Atlas. From now until February 2029, this study will document the birds that are living in Pennsylvania.

In order to accomplish this large task, they are looking for volunteers to look for birds, document any they see and report the details to eBird (<u>Pennsylvania Bird Atlas - Discover a new world of birding... (ebird.org</u>)

Those who are interested should visit the website and create an account to access all the information and tools needed. You will find a volunteer handbook with printouts and be able to track what others are seeing in real time. There is no level of expertise needed to volunteer. Anterless Deer License

- August 12 will start the third round of license sales for resident & non-residents. The sale of Deer Management Assistance Program (DMAP) permits will also be sold at this time.
- August 24 a hunter can additional licenses until reaching their personal limit of 6.

The 2024/2025 Deer Season starts September 24, 2024 and runs till January 25, 2025.


