Summer Activity

The juniors will finish the season on July 1st and restart at Open House. So far, we have juniors attending the National Matches at Camp Perry and the ORPA SB Camp this summer. Paul will be volunteering at the National Matches to support our junior team.

Ammunition

The junior team has used over 16,000 rounds since Jan 1st. We typically use between 30,000-45000 rounds per year. Thanks to Vista Outdoors and Eagle Point Gun's Michael Gess for providing ammunition at special pricing for the junior rifle club. (2024 ammunition usage was 30,000 rounds). Between camps and Nationals, we expect to expend about 5k rounds over the summer.

Grants/Endowment

The junior team applied for the Midway USA Foundation Cash Grant under the endowment program. We are eligible for about \$1400 dollars. As the endowment grows so does the grant. You can donate directly to our endowment through Midway USA Foundation (Midway matches the donation \$100 makes a \$200 endowment increase), or through PYSA (Pennsylvania Youth Shooting Association) who matches your donation, then sends to Midway who matches again (\$100 makes a \$400 endowment increase).


