ISA Post 228 Daisy BB & Air Rifle Instructional Course



The Spring 2025 Daisy BB & Air Rifle Instructional Course began on Sunday, March 2 with 26 students. After the first class (which covers safety), students split time between the range and class.

During the 3rd class, the students were divided into 2 groups and split time between the range, shooting off of sand bags, and classroom time where we reviewed parts of a rifle and sight pictures.

The 4th class was a new challenge. They were divided into 3 groups which would rotate through the stations. The first group went on the indoor range and were shooting from standing and prone positions. The second group went to the archery range to shoot bow & arrow. The third group went into the classroom for learning and quizzes.

We have 2 more classes left for this group. For the last class, the students will be shooting .22 rifles on the inside range off of sand bags, as well as a recap of the entire course and presentation of their certificates. The next course will be held in the fall.
